Currently the Commander, Cliff Gagnon, has been diligently working on getting the Posse set up as a private volunteer organization, including setting up 501c3 status, getting the vehicles appropriately insured and re-branded, and working with other local communities that have gone in the same direction, so the setup and re-training will all go smoothly.

Since the June 12th meeting, there have been a few people who indicated they would like to volunteer to patrol the neighborhoods. We're excited to have new members and are looking for more volunteers, so that we can provide this service for as many hours a day as possible. # IN MEMORIAM

IRMGARD RENKWITZ FENGER

July 10, 1929 – June 19, 2019

Irmgard "Daisy" Fenger, 89, from Mesa, Arizona, passed away on June 19, 2019. She was born on July 10, 1929 in Saughwethen, Germany (formerly East Prussia) and enjoyed a rural childhood in eastern Germany until the start of World War II, at which time she and her family were forced to flee from their home. They eventually restarted their lives in Schlesien, which is Poland today.

After marriage, Irmgard and her husband, Willy, moved to the United States in the 1960s, where they settled in Milwaukee, Wisconsin, with their two sons, Jeffry and Claus. Irmgard moved to Mesa in the 1980s, where she loved the climate, her garden and swimming in her Dreamland community. Irmgard was fiercely independent and a wonderful storyteller.

Irmgard is survived by her grandson, Jon Greiner, and preceded in death by her husband and sons.

No services will be held according to her wishes.

Our biggest attributes are our many medical items such as bath tub whirlpool, bed pans, body lift, commodes, toilet risers (with and without handrails), kneewalkers that fold, canes of all different kinds (some quads, some folding, etc.), crutches, C-walkers, wheeled walkers wheelchairs, just to mention a few. All of which I might add are completely gone through by our full time technician who works very hard on making sure the equipment is sanitized and brought up to medical technical equipment standards.






# The Guest List by Fern Michaels


