## Arizona Day Trips

Bashas' Art Gallery

I never really thought that I cared all that much about Western Art or Native American Art until I went to this wonderful absolutely Art Gallery. The Zelma Basha Salmeri Gallery of Western American and American Indian Art has perhaps the largest collection of Western Art and Native American Art I've ever seen. have I changed my mind

about that!

Walking into the lobby area my mind was blown away with the most impressive contemporary art of this type I've seen. Right away the bold colors and outstanding craftsmanship of sculptures will take your breath away.

As I walked through the gallery, I was transported in time in a sense that the artwork depicted so much of how the west was in the early pioneer days. I felt as if I could really get a sense of how cowboys and Indians or Native Americans really lived in those times. Nearly all the paintings showed life on the plains and prairies, the cattle drives, the campsites, villages, the horses, the buffalo hunts and so much more of the kind of lives they lived in old times. Fantastic portraits of the Native

Americans; sculpture with minute details, all were so impressive.

A good many of the art pieces are painted by artists of a most talented group called the Cowboy Artists of American History. Included under a few of the paintings was the story behind the painting telling us the history and way of life as it was then. Transported in time, I was (as Yoda might have said).

The gallery includes many beautiful pieces of pottery of both traditional and contemporary designs. One room has handmade baskets with so many different designs on each one. I'd bet there isn't one like another in the whole display. Beautiful! The sculpture was amazing in its detail and depiction of the old west. On display as well were some beautiful Native American made jewelry of turquoise, shells,



coral and more. Many Native American tribes' artwork are represented here including Hope Katsinas (or as I always called them, Kachinas).

The Basha Gallery is only open Monday through Friday from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. Going there on side streets we encountered a lot of road work and closed streets. So, I'd recommend heading out on Hwy 60 to Country Club Dr. Go south on Country Club (although the street name changes into Arizona Ave. below Guadalupe) to Ocotillo Rd. Turn right on Ocotillo to Bashas Rd. and turn left on Bashas Rd. A short distance on the right side you will see the Bashas corporate offices and the Gallery is located in their building. Parking is a bit limited but you can find one. They recommend calling before coming in case they close that day.... 480-895-5230.

# Dreamland Villa Memory Bricks



September -- where did the time go! Summer passed quickly and now we begin to think about winter visitors come back in a month or two.

The art room remodeling is coming along nicely. Shelves are up, more electrical outlets, new wall paint will give us a fresh new look.

For those of you contemplating taking a class but not sure which medium to use I found this article about the choosing between oils and acrylics. (from emptyeasel.com)

Pros and cons: oil paints vs. acrylics.

Oil paints have survived for hundreds of years, so their long-

lasting quality is well known. They do tend to discolor with age, something that acrylics don't seem to do, although acrylics haven't been around long enough for us to really know.

When it comes to color, oil paints have more pigment in them, allowing richer, more vivid colors. Acrylics may also darken slightly as they dry, while oil paints do not

The drying time also influences other aspects of painting. Mixing acrylics is more difficult than mixing oils, simply because the acrylics are already beginning to dry. With oils you can mix colors for days on end, producing subtle color variations that you won't have time to make with acrylics.

You'll also need to clean your brushes quickly after finishing painting with acrylics—wait too long and the bristles will be full of dried paint. On the other hand, cleanup with plain old water is a snap compared to oil paints, where you'll need to use Turpentine or Mineral Spirits (both toxic) to clean your brushes and hands.

Acrylic paints are also cheaper than oils, so for students or hobbyists, it's much easier on the pocketbook. They're also a bit more versatile than oils. You can dilute acrylic paint with water and use it in an entirely different way, almost like watercolors.

So are oils the right choice for you? Or acrylics?

If you're a slow painter, deliberate and cautious (perhaps used to spending hours on a single drawing) then I'd recommend oils. You'll need to prop the windows open and wear your paint clothes, but at least you won't have to rush.

On the other hand, if you're concerned about toxicity of the paint, whether around children or pets (or yourself), acrylics might be the choice for you. Invest in all the extras that you'll need, however, like retarders, pastes, and gels which will give you the biggest range of texture and drying

The other main consideration of course involves cost. Acrylics ARE cheaper. Sometimes oil paintings will sell for more (making it worthwhile), but that's really not a sure thing. If money is the bottom line, you'll save a lot by avoiding high end oils.

If you can, find an artist willing to let you dabble a bit with their paint before you make your decision, and then purchase the best paints you can afford.

Contemplating watercolors? It is a more difficult medium to learn than oils or acrylics. Mistakes are not as easy to fix. More about this medium in the next Wet Paint article.


