## President's Message

Depression in seniors is a profoundly important issue that frequently goes unnoticed, yet it can lead to significant consequences if left unaddressed. As individuals age, they often face considerable life changes such as retirement, the loss of loved ones, various physical health challenges, and, at times, isolation from their communities. These experiences can understandably foster feelings of sadness and loneliness. However, when such emotions persist and start to interfere with daily functioning, they may indicate clinical depression rather than being a mere byproduct of aging.

Sadly, depression among older adults is often underdiagnosed. Many seniors may hesitate to share their feelings, believing they should simply "tough it out" or that their emotional struggles are an unavoidable part of getting older. Symptoms of depression can also sometimes be mistaken for other health concerns, such as memory loss or fatigue, delaying the essential help they may need.

The repercussions of untreated depression can be profound. It can exacerbate existing health conditions, impede recovery from illness or surgery, and significantly diminish quality of life. Additionally, depression can lead to poor nutrition, substance abuse, and neglect of personal hygiene, which further jeopardize physical health. Most alarmingly, older adults exhibit the highest rates of suicide compared to other age groups, emphasizing the urgent need for increased focus on mental health within this demographic.

Recognizing early signs of depression is crucial. Families, caregivers, and healthcare professionals should remain attentive to changes in mood, appetite, sleep patterns, and social interactions. By fostering open conversations about mental health, encouraging social engagement, and seeking professional support when needed, we can profoundly impact the lives of our senior loved ones.

There are various resources available for those seeking help, including the National Suicide Prevention Lifeline at 988 and the National Alliance on Mental Illness (NAMI) at 1-800-950-NAMI. By addressing depression with compassion and promptness, we can help older adults lead healthier, more fulfilling lives.

**Safety Tips for Retired Women**  
Retirement in Arizona offers beautiful weather, scenic landscapes, and a vibrant community of fellow retirees. However, staying safe—whether at home, online, or out in public—is key to maintaining peace of mind and independence. Here are practical safety tips for retired women living in Arizona:

**Stay Cool and Hydrated**  
Arizona’s dry, hot climate can be dangerous, especially in the summer. Stay indoors during peak heat hours (10 am to 4 pm), wear light clothing, and drink plenty of water—even if you don’t feel thirsty. Keep a water bottle with you when running errands or walking outdoors.

**Secure Your Home**  
Install good lighting around entrances, lock all doors and windows, and consider a security system or video doorbell. Get to know your neighbors and join a neighborhood watch program if available. If you’re away for extended periods, ask a trusted friend or neighbor to check on your home and put in a vacation check with the Dreamland Villa Posse.

**Be Alert When Out and About**  
Avoid walking alone at night, and stick to well-lit areas. Carry a fully charged cell phone and let someone know where you’re going. If using public transportation, stay alert and sit near the driver or other passengers. Be aware, don’t look down at your phone, look around, and know your surroundings.

**Protect Your Finances**  
Scams targeting seniors are common, especially through phone calls, emails, and social media. Never give out personal information or send money to unfamiliar people. Hang up on suspicious callers, and check with a family member or trusted friend before acting on financial requests.

**Take Care Online**  
Use strong, unique passwords and enable two-factor authentication for important accounts. Avoid clicking on links in unsolicited messages, and update your software regularly to protect against viruses and malware.

**Maintain Your Health**  
Keep up with regular doctor visits and stay active to reduce the risk of falls and health complications. If you live alone, consider a medical alert system in case of emergencies.

Staying safe in Arizona is all about staying prepared, staying aware, and staying connected. By taking a few simple precautions, retired women can enjoy all the freedom and beauty the Grand Canyon State has to offer.

## BOOK REVIEW

### HORSE BY GERALDINE BROOKS

I have always liked horses, so when a friend recommended this book, I was very interested in reading it. I’m sure glad I did, it’s excellent. This author always does a lot of research, and besides being entertained, I always learn a lot from her books. This is historical fiction. The information about Lexington, the famous race horse in the 1800s, is true, and a lot of the characters in the book are real. It’s a story of the true devotion of a young black male who was present when Lexington was born and was with him until his death many years later. The boy, Jarret, was a slave who was very good with horses. If there were a horse whisperer, he could have been that person. The story

takes place in several states as they move around the racing world. There is also a painter who paints horses who is in the story.

There is another story set in 2019. Theo is a black art historian, and Jess, a Smithsonian scientist; they find themselves unexpectedly connected through their shared interest in the horse. One is studying the stallions’ bones for the clue to their speed and endurance, the other is uncovering the lost history of the artist who painted pictures of them, and the black horsemen who were critical to these horses’ racing success. Racism rears its ugly head at the end of this book. It’s a novel of art and science, love and obsession.
