mandated by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development – Housing for Older Persons Act (HUD-HOPA) and Maricopa County to maintain Dreamland Villa's status as a 55+ age-restricted community. According to Dreamland Villa Retirement Community (DVRC) Policy and Procedures, "Each dwell-

ing unit in Dreamland must have at least one occupant that is 55 years of age or older."

Thank you for your support and commitment, and we ask your continued support for next year's committee to preserve Dreamland Villa as a vibrant 55+ community.

IN MEMORIAM

William "Bill" L. Cooper, born July 13, 1943, to William L. Cooper Sr. and Louise (Steapp) Cooper, passed away on March 18, 2026.

Bill was a man of many titles throughout his life—son, brother, husband, father, grandfather, great-grandfather, uncle, and friend. Above all, he was a devoted family man who worked tirelessly to provide for and support his children, no matter the distance between them.

He had a passion for life that showed in everything he did. Bill loved fast cars, dirt bike racing, street bikes, hustled as a pool player, flew and instructed for Ul-

tra Lights, playing bridge, and dominos ("bones"), which he especially enjoyed playing and teaching to his grandchildren. He found joy in adventure, but one of his greatest passions was teaching his children about life lessons that they will carry with them forever.

Bill was preceded in death by his father, William L. Cooper Sr. (July 6, 1962); his mother, Louise Cooper (May 25, 2005); his beloved wife Carol Cooper (April 1, 2017); his oldest son, William J. Cooper (July 6, 2023); and his sister, Marylou (May 14, 2025).

He is survived by his siblings: brother Joe, and sisters

Gerry and Paula. He was also survived by his sister Pat, who sadly passed just eight days later on March 26, 2026.

Bill leaves behind his loving children: Melissa (Lewie) Hart, Leslie (Robert) Thompson, and Chase (Brandy) Cooper. He is also survived by several grandchildren, many great-grandchildren, and numerous nieces and nephews who will continue to honor his memory.

During his first marriage to Loretta, Bill welcomed three children. Later, in his marriage to Carol, they welcomed their youngest son, Chase, completing their family.

Bill spent his life working hard in many roles, including as a pool cleaner, window washer, Pest Control, construction worker, before retiring as an Industrial/Commercial painter. His strong work ethic and dedication to his family were evident in everything he did. Though he traveled to many states throughout his life, Bill spent his later years in Mesa, Arizona, where he made his home.

Book Review

The River We Remember by William Kent Krueger

This has become one of my very favorite authors. He really quickly draws the reader into the story and makes all the characters come alive and real. I laughed, I cried, and I couldn't put this book down. There is love, there is hatred, and there are family relationships, some good, some bad. The story starts on Memorial Day 1958 in

a small southern Minnesota town as the people gather for the parade and celebration. The half-clothed body of wealthy landowner Jimmy Quinn is found floating in the nearby Alabaster River. He is NOT a well-liked man in the community, and a lot of the locals are not unhappy about him being dead, but how did he die? Was it suicide, was he murdered, and if so, by whom? The fingers immediately start pointing at Noah Bluestone, a native American war veteran who has a Japanese wife; there is a lot of old hatred toward those 2 races. Sheriff Brody Dern, who is

also a local war hero, is responsible for the investigation and solving of this case. It's a great story based on actual people that this author knew and could relate to. Maybe I should call it historical fiction. It asks the question, "Does our past have to influence our present?" It also includes two young boys growing up and the things they have to deal with. How much is additional fiction, and how much is fact? The epilogue tells the rest of the story about the people in the book, which was also interesting.

Summer Safety Reminders: Stay Cool, Stay Safe!

Your safety and security matter to us, which is why we share helpful tips each month — some you may already know, but a friendly reminder never hurts!

This month, it's all about June in Arizona. Welcome to summer, where the desert turns up the heat, and the sun means business!

Beat the Heat

June temperatures in the lower deserts routinely climb between 105-115°F, and with very little humidity, dehydration sneaks up on you fast. The rule of thumb: if you feel thirsty, you're already dehydrated. Drink water early and often — don't wait until your body is begging for it.

With nearly 14.5 hours of daylight daily (peaking around the summer solstice on June 20-21), the sun has plenty of time to do damage. Protect yourself by:

- Wearing sunscreen and a hat
- Limiting outdoor activity during peak heat hours
- Moving to a cool area if you're feeling overheated

Heat and sunstroke are very real dangers. If you can't cool down, don't tough it out — call 911 and get medical attention. The heat is no joke.

Don't Let the Dark Work Against You

Here's an interesting flip side: those cooler nighttime temps (staying below 90°F) are when the not-so-friendly folks tend to come out. They're counting on the cover of darkness and the assumption that you're sound asleep.

Don't make it easy for them! Keep your porch light on, light up your carport, and add some backyard lighting. A great budget-friendly option? Solar-powered motion-activated lights — affordable, effective, and no wiring required. Also, check that your street lights are working. If one is out, look for the pole number and report it to SRP.

Stay cool, stay covered, and stay alert. Wishing everyone a safe and enjoyable summer in our wonderful community!

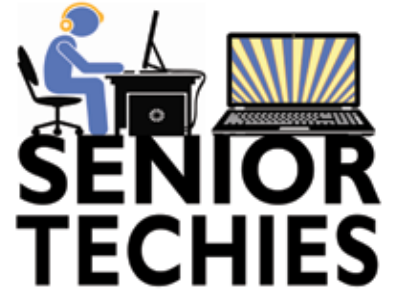

TUESDAY AFTERNOONS – NEEDLE WORKERS- NO COST. 1:00 pm – 3:30 pm

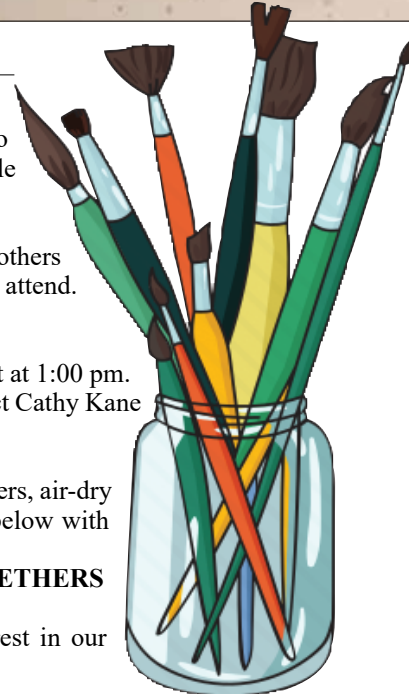

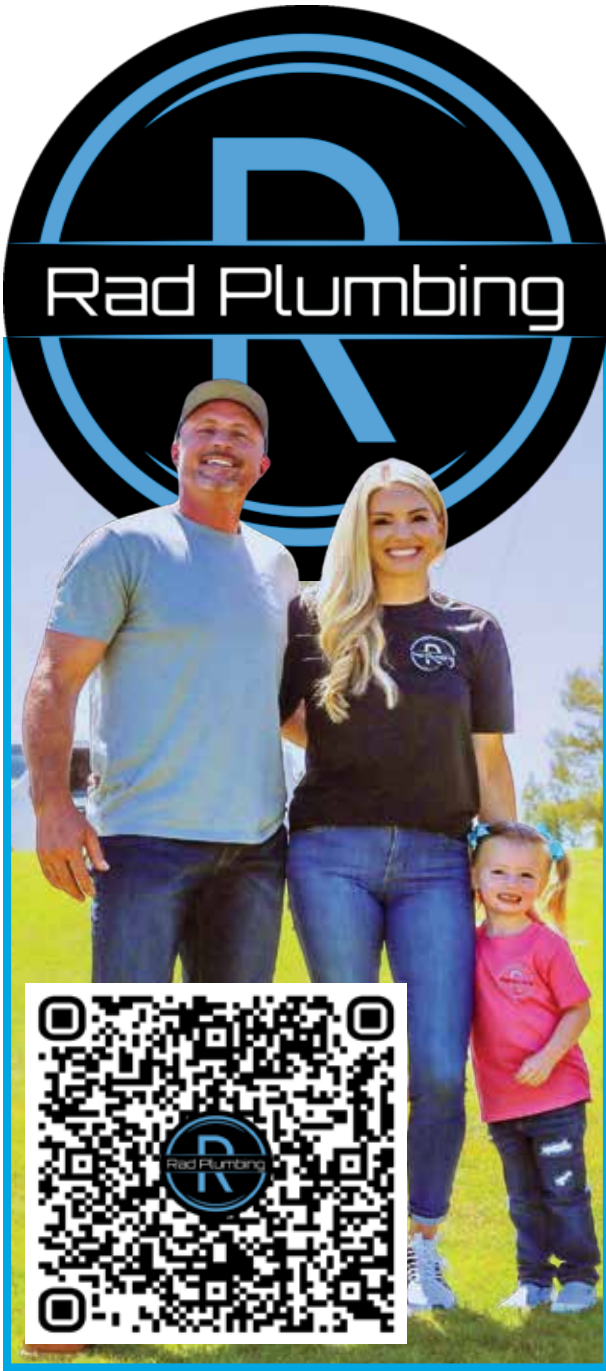

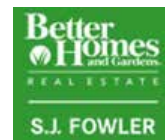
